## Middle School Grammar and Language Composition

In this class, students will practice all different types of writing, such as personal narratives, creative stories, persuasive essays, and expository writing. Emphasis is placed on organization and grammar, though, with occasional grammar exercises assigned as well. Writers of all levels are encouraged to apply.

## Informational Writing

This course is intended to strengthen students' academic writing skills. Special attention is given to developing ideas, writing clear theses, using evidence from sources to support claims, organizing material, and revising drafts. Motivated students are encouraged to apply as this research-driven class aims to challenge!

## Fiction Writing

Ready, set, write! In this class, we'll focus on creative writing, helping your child develop his or her unique writer's voice. Strong writers interested in being exposed to well-crafted short stories and collaborative storytelling are encouraged to apply!

## SAT Vocabulary

To help ensure students succeed on the SAT, we'll cover vocabulary that has commonly appeared on previous exams. Note that students who have previously enrolled are encouraged to apply again; we'll be working with a new set of words!

## High School and SAT Grammar

In this course, students will practice Writing and Language sections from older SATs, as well material from the Reading and Writing section of the newly designed digital SAT. Students can anticipate the occasional essay, but emphasis is placed on standardized test prep, grammar rules, and terminology associated with grammar.

## Six Traits Writing

Research shows that all “good” writing has six key ingredients- ideas, organization, voice, word choice, sentence fluency, and conventions. In this class, students will use this model to assess their strengths and weaknesses, practicing both fiction and nonfiction writing.

\*\*Public Speaking - Is your child ready for a fun challenge? In this class, students will mainly practice persuasive and argumentative writing, in addition to their delivery of said writing. Students will learn techniques needed to command an audience’s attention and appear a confident, likable speaker.
